(Washington, DC) – Today, Mayor Muriel Bowser released the following statement on the path forward for making DC the 51st state in the 117th Congress.

"Washingtonians have waited over 200 years for the representation we deserve as American citizens. And it is not just the residents of DC who bear the burden of our disenfranchisement. To paraphrase Dr. King: when any American is denied democracy, our entire nation is denied those voices and votes. But now, we are ready to finally fix this injustice by getting statehood on President Biden's desk within the first 100 days of the 117th Congress. With our seats at the table, we can help build back better than ever before. Just like the millions of Americans who voted nationwide and the thousands who organized and voted in Georgia, we are ready to build a more perfect union – one in which all voices are heard, one in which we work together to uplift families in cities, and suburbs, and small towns, and one in which the 712,000 residents of Washington, DC have full access to our nation's democracy."

Dear Acting Attorney General Rosen, Secretary McCarthy, and Acting Secretary Miller:


As the law enforcement agency charged with protecting residents and visitors throughout the District of Columbia, the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) is prepared for this week's First Amendment activities. MPD has coordinated with its federal partners, namely the US Park Police, US Capitol Police and the US Secret Service—all of whom regularly have uniformed personnel protecting federal assets in the District of Columbia. This week, MPD has additional logistical support of unarmed members of the DC National Guard, who will work under the direction of, and in coordination with, MPD.

The District of Columbia Government has not requested personnel from any other federal law enforcement agencies. To avoid confusion, we ask that any request for additional assistance be coordinated using the same process and procedures.

We are mindful that in 2020, MPD was expected to perform the demanding tasks of policing large crowds while working around unidentifiable personnel deployed in the District of Columbia without proper coordination. Unidentifiable personnel—in many cases, armed—caused confusion among residents and visitors and could become a national security threat with no way for MPD and federal law enforcement to decipher armed groups.

To be clear, the District of Columbia is not requesting other federal law enforcement personnel and discourages any additional deployment without immediate notification to, and consultation with, MPD if such plans are underway. The protection of persons and property is our utmost concern and responsibility. MPD is well trained and prepared to lead the law enforcement, coordination and response to allow for the peaceful demonstration of First Amendment rights in the District of Columbia.

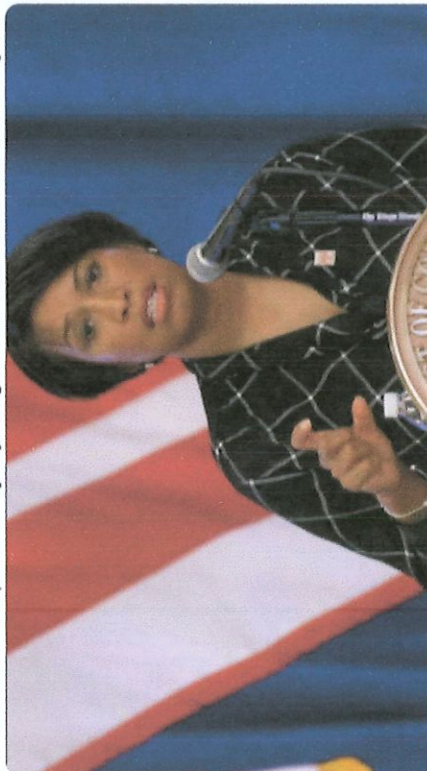

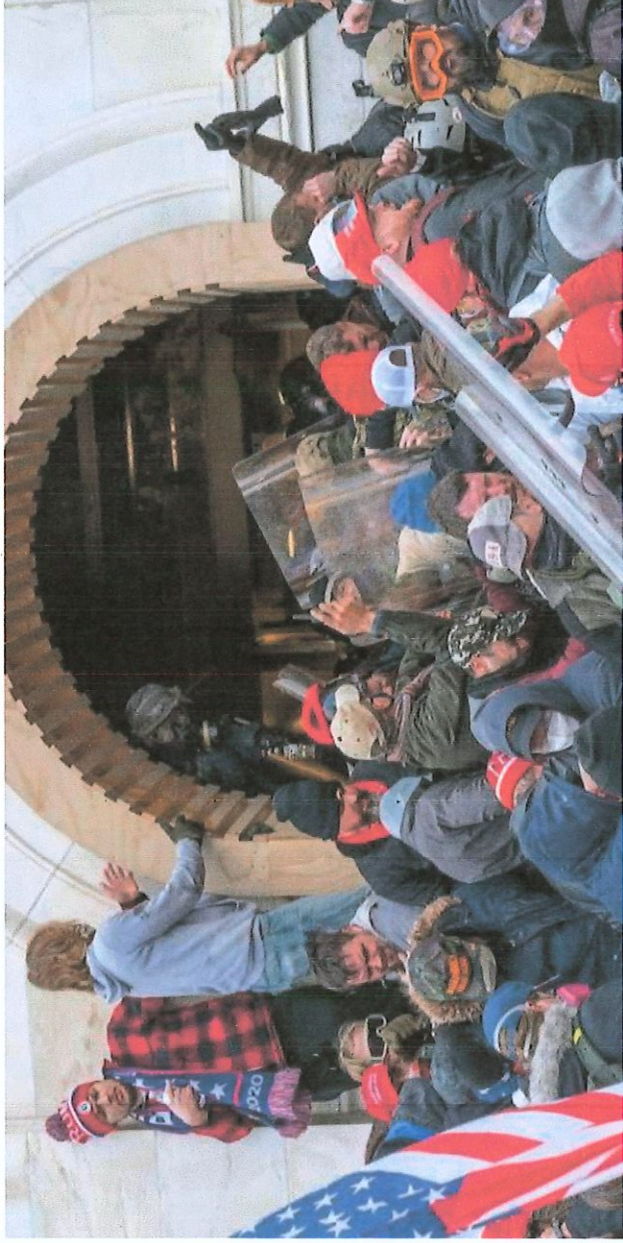

- Washington, DC Mayor Muriel Bowser says the invasion of the Capitol Wednesday was "textbook terrorism" and what President Donald Trump "wanted to happen."
- She criticized the Capitol Police for security failures and called for an investigation.
- Bowser also renewed calls for DC statehood, saying that if she were a governor she would have been able to activate the National Guard more quickly.

Washington, DC Mayor Muriel Bowser criticized President Donald Trump for the mob of his supporters who invaded the US Capitol Wednesday, calling their actions "textbook terrorism," and called on Congress to grant the district statehood so that her office would have the authority to implement greater security measures.

"The current president must be held accountable for this unprecedented attack on our democracy. What happened yesterday is what he wanted to happen, and we must not underestimate the damage he can do to our nation and our democracy over the next two weeks," she said at a press conference Thursday.

Bowser also criticized the Capitol Police force, which is distinct from the DC Metropolitan Police under her control, for Wednesday's security failures. She requested that a terrorism task force investigate Wednesday's events.

While Metro police chief Robert Contee spoke at Thursday's press conference, the Capitol Police force did not have its chief or any spokespeople participating. Moments before the meeting began, Capitol Police Chief Steven Sund distributed a statement saying his officers "responded valiantly" to the mob.
